

Dover Race Series statement concerning COVID-19

The Dover Race Series (DRS) sends our thoughts to those around the world who are being impacted by the coronavirus (COVID-19). Our primary concern is the health and safety of our race participants and event staff in our community. The DRS is continuing to monitor the developing situation closely and reviewing the impact to our series as a whole.

Each DRS race has the authority to make their own decision regarding cancellation or postponement. Last night, our first race, Run Before You Crawl, has announced that it will postpone for the time being.

Our April races (Red's Race and SMA 5K) are in the process of evaluating their decision and response. At this time, the DRS is looking at its options for how to adapt the series this year. As we are a committee of 11 races, this is not an easy task and we ask for your patience as we navigate through this rapidly evolving landscape.

We will continue to closely monitor our options as new information becomes available and will adjust as determined to be appropriate along the way. We will continue to communicate with updates as they are available.
